Nomination Form

To become a Fellow of the European Academy of Sciences, the candidate has to be nominated by a Fellow of EurASc. The nominator has to complete this form and provide, together with the completed nomination form (please see below), the following documents – *merged into a single PDF*:

- A letter of nomination ;
 - A recent CV of the candidate ;
 - A list of the 10 most important publications of the candidate, including their number of citations (as indicated by Web of Science or Google Scholar) ;
 - 1 or 2 letters of support (at least one of which should be from a Fellow of EurASc).
- The nominator **cannot** also write the letters of support, this means that the candidate has to be nominated by one member of EurASc and supported by, at least, one other member of EurASc.

If one of these documents is missing, the nomination will be considered invalid. The total length of these documents, when merged into a single PDF, should not exceed 10 pages. Additional documents (such as a citation report, a short bio, a complete list of publications, etc.) can also be provided.
