

Anders Hagfeldt is Vice-Chancellor of Uppsala University since 2021 and Professor of Physical Chemistry. He obtained his PhD at Uppsala University in 1993. His research has focused on the fields of dyesensitized solar cells, perovskite solar cells and solar fuels. He has published more than 680 scientific papers that have received over 110,000 citations. 2014-2020 he was Professor at The Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne (EPFL).

Topic

"Europe can seize the opportunity through investment in knowledge societies and the role of Guild"

To solve common issues (such as health, environment, and digital concerns) and promote competitive European relations to knowledge societies in low and middle-income countries, universities and research performing groups should unite to emphasize the significance of increasing financing for the Global Gateway. To fully exploit the promise of the Global Gateway policy, the Guild calls for more investment at both the national and European levels. A 360-degree strategy across all Global Gateway goals must better combine research, innovation, and higher education to maintain competitiveness. Increasing investment in these areas would boost Europe's competitiveness, resilience, and readiness.
